

What to expect on a typical day for a 1.00pm ceremony

- i. Groom arrives no less than 30 minutes before the ceremony
- ii. Guests are to arrive at the same time as the groom. They must have all arrived and be at the meeting point within the sunken lawn no less than 15 minutes before the ceremony
- iii. Groom meets the registrar in the appropriate building above the sunken lawn e.g. 12.45pm
- iv. Groom moves to his ceremony position
- v. Guests join him
- vi. Bride arrives and talks with the registrar 12.50pm
- vii. Ceremony (usually 15-20 min) starts at 1.00pm
- viii. Reception drinks and canapes (if arranged) 1.30pm
- ix. Photographs
- x. Wedding breakfast (if arranged) 3.00pm
